Community Service/Music to Go Program

The **Community Service** program is designed to give students the experience of performing for a variety of audiences, specifically to people who would not otherwise have the opportunity to attend concerts (the elderly, the very young, the disabled). Participants in the program are required to do 4 Community Service performances per semester.

The **Music to Go** program gives students the professional experience of providing music for weddings, parties, corporate events, etc. You are paid for the Music to Go gigs that you for which you are hired.

Auditions for the Community Service/Music to Go Program are held at the same time as regular ensemble auditions (August 22-28).

Everyone must audition for the program each Fall, even if you have been in the program before. Sign-up lists for auditions are posted outside of the Business Office on the 4th floor.
